

# MARCH 4, 2012 MISSIONS SUNDAY

## QUICK FACTS:

This mission trip is a 2-week humanitarian effort in Tegucigalpa, Honduras and its surrounding villages.

This will be Alameda's third year to send a team, ranging in age from 8 to 60+ years.

In the past two years, our teams have helped put a roof over the heads of over 30 families, distributed at least 800 lbs. of food, and brought hope to countless individuals by showing them God's love.



## PURPOSE:

TORCH Mission Teams were presented with a unique opportunity back in the 90's after Hurricane Mitch devastated the city of Tegucigalpa. Already one of the poorest nations in the world, Honduras was (and still is today) in desperate need of food, housing, medical care, and the hope brought only by knowing Jesus. Through the work of local missionaries and countless churches throughout the U.S., TORCH has grown to become a far-reaching mission effort that impacts thousands of children, families, and adults year round. Our team from Alameda only spends two weeks out of each summer working in Honduras, but we are a vital part of a greater work that is bringing the message of Christ's love to the wonderful people of this country by providing for their basic needs "en el nombre de Jesus" (in the name of Jesus).
